



**Zoo Academy Road Trip - Think Globally and Act Locally**  
**Camp Session #15, July 14-18**  
**Monday – Friday: 9:30a – 4:00p**  
**Zoo Academy – Road Trip: \$350/members; \$375/nonmembers**  
**Registration begins March 1, 2008**

Have you ever wondered where all your recyclables go after they are picked up by the city? Do you know why it is so important to protect sensitive wild areas in and around the city? This camp will introduce advanced summer campers to the reality of resource sustainability in and around the city of San Antonio through daily field trips to local natural areas and environmental management sites.

**FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS**

Q. Does my child need to bring a lunch to this camp?

A. Yes, each camper must bring his or her own lunch. The counselor will not stop at any local eating establishments during a road trip.

Q. How will my child get to each of the off Zoo grounds destination during camp?

A. The camp director will be leading this camp and will transport the campers in a 15 passenger van. Campers just need to arrive at the Zoo by 9:30a each morning.

Q. Should I furnish my child with extra money for this camp?

A. Aside from lunch, the camp registration fee covers transportation, snacks, facility entrance fees, and any other expenses.

Q. What type of camper was this session designed for?

A. This camp session was designed for campers with previous Zoo camp experience and those campers with a desire to work in a resource management field.

Q. What do campers actually do during a Zoo Academy Road Trip?

A. Each day campers will depart the Zoo for a field trip to a local natural area or environmental management site. Campers will gain a greater appreciation for the beauty of our local natural areas and a better understanding of what it takes to sustain the environmental health of a large metropolitan area. While at the Zoo they will discuss what they experienced in the field, tour the zoo, discuss wildlife conservation and experience animal presentations.
